GENERAL INFORMATION

This certificate relates only to the condition of the vehicle at the time of testing. It should not be regarded as evidence of the condition of the vehicle at any other time. When you purchase a vehicle you should not regard this Test Certificate as a warranty. This Certificate does not remove the responsibility from the registered owner to regularly service and maintain the vehicle in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Do not use on public roads any vehicle which is subject to periodic test unless a test certificate is in force for the vehicle. Therefore a new certificate should be obtained on or before the expiry date overleaf. If the vehicle is to continue in use on the roads in Northern Ireland, you should apply for a new certificate at least **one month before it is needed**.

You must produce a valid test certificate if asked to do so by a police constable or authorised officer. If you do not produce your certificate within five days when asked to do so you are liable on conviction to a fine. A valid test certificate must be produced when applying for a Vehicle Excise Licence at your local Vehicle Licensing Office. You are therefore advised to keep this certificate readily available while it is in force.
