Driver & Vehicle Agency - Testing

Please read this notice and then click on the link at the bottom of the page to continue with the booking process.

The data controller for personal information collected by the Driver & Vehicle Agency (DVA) is the Department of the Environment (DOE). The DVA is an executive agency of the DOE and as such directly manages all personal information it collects and processes. For the purpose of administering and conducting a variety of vehicle and driving tests, DVA is the data processor and is authorised to collect and process personal information

Personal information will be processed primarily to register driving candidates, confirm identity and entitlement, book driving and vehicle test appointments and provide tests (including results), statistical management information, including a variety of analysis to assess the effectiveness of initiatives to improve both customer service and road safety.

Personal information is also used to provide links for validating and enabling the lawful provision of driver and vehicle licences by the Driver and Vehicle Licensing division (DVA - Licensing).

No further disclosures shall be made by the DVA other than in accordance with the law, to comply with legal obligations and in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. Such disclosures are listed in the DOE's entry, which can be found in the UK Information Commissioner's Public Register of Data Controllers.
